

Sponsor-a-Trail Request

For the past 20 years supporters of the DATA Trail system have had the opportunity to be a trail sponsor and have their name or business name on 2 special signs erected along the DATA trail during the winter snowmobile season. This program came about because of the need to raise matching dollars to supplement the reimbursement funding which comes from the state and is used to pay about \$1 out of every \$3 of the expense incurred by DATA in building, maintenance and grooming of our 366 miles of snowmobile trails. Each sponsored mile represents a \$100 contribution to DATA's annual fundraising effort to pay for our 1/3 share of the operating cost of maintaining our snowmobile trails.

DATA added a 4th Tucker last fall so we can more easily groom the Central Lakes Trail, as well as have a backup groomer if a breakdown occurs, or provide additional grooming on great snow like we had last year. Your contribution would greatly help the equipment fund as we will be making groomer payments which come out of our available grooming dollars for several years

DATA will not be holding a fundraising banquet this year. Instead we are planning on hosting the Minnesota United Snowmobilers Association (MnUSA) Winter Rendezvous and Governor's / VIP Ride this February 10th – 13th at the Arrowwood Resort & Conference Center on Lake Darling.
